

# Recycling Information

## What can go in my green box?

✓ Glass drinks bottles, glass food jars, drinks cans, food tins and cans, metal lids from jars and metal sweet and biscuit tins.

✗ Sheet of plate glass, corks, Pyrex dishes, broken glass or mirrors, light bulbs and paint tins.

## What can go in my green bags?

✓ Yoghurt pots, plastic food trays, tubs, containers and fruit punnets, plastic bottles and lids and plant pots.

OR

✓ Newspapers and magazines, envelopes, junk mail, books, catalogues, cereal boxes, card, cardboard egg boxes, telephone directories and shredded paper.

✗ Plastic bags, soft plastic wrapping, polystyrene, crisp packets, cling film or bubble wrap, plastic toys, wallpaper, wrapping paper, soiled paper and tissue, waxed paper, foil backed card, card with padding or bubble wrap, and juice, milk and food cartons.

**Both bags may be used for EITHER plastic OR paper and card but these items must not be mixed.**

## What can go in my garden waste bin?

✓ Grass clippings, plants, flowers, leaves, hedge prunings, twigs, small branches, weeds and real Christmas trees. **Only Christmas trees placed in bins will be collected.**

✗ Kitchen food waste and peelings, soil, compost, stones or rubble, paper, garden chemicals, pet waste and any other non-compostable items.

## What to do with your recycling?

Please place your recycling for collection, by the kerbside, before 7am on the collection day, taking care not to cause any obstruction. Please make sure your recycling is clearly visible to the collection crew.

Some residents may have to place their recycling at a central collection point. The Council will have already notified you, if this is the case.

Please make sure all recycled materials are clean and free from food waste to avoid attracting wildlife and vermin. Please rinse and crush plastic bottles and cans as much as possible. There is no need to remove the labels. Please also flatten any cardboard as much as possible.

**Please only present recycling in the containers provided by the Council.**
